Timeline for Planning and Early Implementation Year (2005-2006)

August 12, 2005	RFP for School Redesign: Expanding Learning Time to Support Student Success - <i>Planning and Early Implementation Grants</i> released and posted on Department of Education website.
From August 15, 2005 to September 30, 2005	Districts identify rationale and readiness for participation; identify schools to participate accompanied by school data and goals; identify key personnel and possible partnerships; develop budget for planning activities; establish a planning process for developing an implementation plan; prepare planning and early implementation grant application for submission to the Department of Education.
Thursday, August 18 at 9:30a.m. Wednesday, August 24 at 10:00a.m.	Department of Education convenes conference calls to provide technical assistance to districts interested in applying for Planning and Early Implementation grants.
Friday, September 30, 2005	Deadline for school districts to submit applications for Planning and Early Implementation grants to the Department of Education.
Tuesday, November 1, 2005	Deadline for the Department of Education to review all qualified proposals and award planning grants.
From November 1, 2005 to January 14, 2006	Each district awarded a Planning and Early Implementation grant creates a detailed Expanded Learning Time implementation plan. [Guidance for Implementation Plan components will be provided.]
Thursday, November 10, 2005 (tentative)	The Department of Education and partners provide technical assistance session to districts that received Planning and Early Implementation grants awards to support the development of Implementation Plans.
Thursday, December 1, 2005	Department of Education issues report to the Legislature estimating FY2007 costs to fully fund all district implementation plans under development at that time. The report will include the names and total number of districts awarded planning grants, and the total number of schools and students named in the planning grant applications.
Friday, January 13, 2006	Deadline for districts to submit Implementation Plans to the Department of Education.
Wednesday, February 15, 2006	Department of Education notifies districts if their Implementation Plan meets criteria for approval.
January – August, 2006	Early implementation activities conducted by district in preparation for opening of redesigned school(s) in September 2006.
