- (B) The district operates one or more schools identified under section 1116 of ESEA **or** the district has a substantial need for assistance in acquiring and using technology, based on the guidelines stated in the "Local Technology Plan Guidelines for School Years 2007-2010 "

(II) For this grant program, a school district must have a student enrollment of 200 or more to be considered as a high-need school district.

(III) The high-need districts in this list have up-to-date approved technology plans.

(IV) This list is based on the 2008 U. S. Census (the 2009 data were not published at the time the FY 2010 Request for Proposals were issued.)
